**THE SIMPLE RULES:** Points will be awarded for performance in each event as follows: Novelty Group: 1st-10, 2nd-7 3rd-5, 4th-3, 5th-1. Adventure & Courage Groups: 20 points maximum for each group at the discretion of the M.C.

To be eligible for the **MOST VERSATILE MASTIFF** Trophy, a dog must have participated in the **NOVELTY** Group and at least **ONE** other; and the Trophy will be awarded to the mastiff gaining the most points at the end of the afternoon. In the event of a "draw", a tie-break event will decide the winner.

The running order of events will be decided by the Stewards on the day (depending on the weather and any other relevant factors).
